Elections in the Utah Republican Party's state nominating convention elections determine whether a primary will be held in a given race. If at any time a candidate has 60% or more of the vote in any round, that person becomes the party's sole nominee. If, after all rounds, no candidate receives 60% or more, the top two finishers advance to a primary. (Exhausted ballots are not counted in calculating final percentages.)

Winners: Tim Bridgewater and John Swallow.
Neither received 60% or more. Both advance to a primary.
